Four days and three nights in four-star hotels; all meals and entry fees included.

June 7 - 11, 2010

- June 7: Cross into Jordan; view Pella, Jerash and Amman; overnight in Amman.
- June 8: Travel along the King's Highway from Amman to Madaba to Mt. Nebo to Karak and to Petra; overnight in Petra
- June 9: Spend a whole day visiting Petra (biblical Bozrah, Edom). Drive to, and overnight in Aqaba
- June 10: Tour Aqaba and Wadi Rum. Drive back into Israel; overnight in Israel
- June 11: Depart for New York/Newark
